

B Jacket Slitter

The smooth, plane-like shaving action of this simple tool lets you quickly remove the polyethylene covering from the jacketed messenger on figure-8 cable without hitting the strand or damaging the cable.

- ▶ The tool's wooden handle has a metal cutting guide and steel blade at one end
- ▶ The guide's special design assures that you'll cut to the correct depth every time
- ▶ Replacing the hardened steel blade is just as easy; release two screws in the guide, change blades, and retighten the screws

B Web Slitter

You can use this plier-type tool to slit the web between the strand and cable core on figure 8 cable.

- ▶ All you have to do is hold the block of the slitter parallel to the strand and draw it along the cable and strand
- ▶ This self-guiding tool makes sure the blade pierces the web and not the sheath or strand jacket
- ▶ The cutting blade is held with one screw and reinforced with a square washer to prevent bending
- ▶ Also referred to as a 305B tool
