This tough, blue-handled knife is made of tempered high-carbon 1060 series steel that's designed to hold its edge.

Electrician's Knife & Scissors Sharpener

Sharp cutlery is both easier and safer to use, and you can keep your cutlery at its keenest with this easy-to-use sharpener.

- ▶ Not only will it lengthen the life of your tools, it'll help speed up your splicing by eliminating the bad cuts and frustration that dull tools can cause
- ▶ Just draw the sharpener along the blade of your tool three or four times, and the original edge is restored in seconds
- ▶ The two carbide bits in front are for sharpening knives; to sharpen scissors, just draw the non-serrated edge of your scissors, along the sharpener's single side bit by resting the tool on a flat surface
- ▶ There's no tedious filing, and no cut knuckles either, because the built-in finger guard protects your hand
